Three important directives from 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

- ❖ *Rejoice always* – daily expressing joy and gladness
- ❖ *Pray without ceasing* – daily communing with God and walking in His presence
Psalm 16:11 “*You make known to me the path of life; in Your presence there is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.*”
- ❖ *Give thanks in all circumstances* – daily acknowledging God’s sovereignty in both good and bad!
Job 1:21-22 “*And he said, ‘Naked I came from my mother’s womb, and naked shall I return. The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord.’ In all this Job did not sin or charge God with wrong.*”

Why does God’s Word give us these directives? “*For this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.*”

1. America provides an amazingly good life for the ordinary guy.
Acts 4:34 “*There was not a needy person among them...*”
2. America offers more opportunity and social mobility than any other country, including the countries of Europe.
Matthew 25:14-29 – *The Parable of the Talents*
3. Work and trade are respectable in America, which is not true elsewhere.
Ephesians 6:5-9
4. America has achieved greater social equality than any other society.
Proverbs 22:2 “*The rich and the poor meet together; the Lord is the maker of them all.*”
5. People live longer, fuller lives in America.
1 Timothy 6:17-19

6. In America, the destiny of the young is not given to them but is created by them.
Proverbs 16:3 "Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established."
7. America has gone further than any other society in establishing equality of rights.
