

Update: July 18, 2020

Executive Order D 2020 138 which amends previous Executive Orders was issued by Colorado Governor Jared Polis on Thursday, July 16<sup>th</sup>. It orders individuals in Colorado to wear a face covering due to the presence of COVID-19 in Colorado. As the WPCC Pastors and Elders have stated previously, we will abide by Executive Orders given by the Governor of the State of Colorado. Praise God for our freedom to continue to gather as the Body of Christ, worship our Lord together, and to proclaim the Gospel. Because face coverings are required in our facility as a public gathering space, we ask that you please wear a face covering as you come to worship with us at WPCC. According to the Amended order, individuals 10 years old & younger and individuals who cannot medically tolerate a face covering are exempt from the requirements of this order. In addition, individuals performing certain duties are exempt which includes officiating at a religious service, therefore, when the pastors and worship team are on stage leading the service, they will not be required to wear a face mask.

We are so excited to be gathering this Sunday to Worship our Lord and Savior!

On June 4<sup>th</sup>, the State of Colorado released [guidelines for Places of Worship](#) and this order increased the number of people that can congregate in a room to **50** as long as social distancing is practiced. Winter Park Christian Church will be meeting for all of our services: Saturday at 6:00am and Sunday at 8:30am and 10:30am English services and the 4:00pm Spanish service. The Fellowship Hall will be available with the Livestream on the large TV if needed. If you do not feel comfortable attending church, please continue to join us on the WPCC Livestream services at 10:30am (English) and 4:00pm (Spanish). For your safety, WPCC is performing frequent cleaning and disinfection of bathrooms and high touch surfaces. Ventilation systems will be operating which circulate outdoor air through the sanctuary, and as much as possible, we will open windows and use the ceiling fans to circulate outdoor air in both the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall. In addition, signage is posted at entrances and throughout the facility to remind people of social distancing and proper hygiene guidelines.

If you attend one of the services this weekend, please remember:

- Social distancing of at least six feet should be practiced at all times between individuals or family groups. Family groups should consist only of members of a single household.
- Please use the one-way entries and exits and practice social distancing as you enter and exit the church.
- Hand Sanitizer will be available for use throughout the church.
- Bottled water **will** be available.
- Food or drinks (including coffee) will **not** be available. Feel free to bring your own coffee, tea, etc. for your own use.
- Do not attend a service in person if you are experiencing the following symptoms:
  - ↳ Cough/shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fever, chills/shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell.

There will be no childcare or Sunday School at the services this weekend. Sarah will continue to give a Children's Message with a Children's video. Bring paper and your child's preferred writing utensils for your children to draw or take notes.
