The Surety of Maturity

January 30th & 31st, 2016

Ephesians 4:13

"until we all attain ... to mature manhood..."

The first three chapters of Ephesians has shown us who we are in Christ and all that we have in Christ! God has seen to it that we are not lacking in anything needed to fulfill God's purpose for our lives! Chapter four directs us to conduct our lives in a manner worthy of our God-given call! The process through which we grow in our understanding of God's call and purpose for our lives is through discipleship – God-gifted teachers and mentors training and equipping each Christian as we grow in unity of the faith, the knowledge of the Son of God, and maturity in Christ!

What does maturity in the Lord look like?

One of the characteristics of maturity is a new focus in our thinking Philippians 3:12-16

<u>Humility</u> in Attitude "Not that I have already attained this..."

Psalm 25:8-9 "Good and upright is the Lord; therefore He instructs sinners in the way. He leads the humble in what is right, and <u>teaches</u> the humble His way."

James 4:6 "But He gives more grace. Therefore it says, 'God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble.'"

- ❖ Humility is not listed among the fruits of the Spirit. (*Galatians 5:22-23*)
- ❖ Humility is something we <u>choose</u> to do!

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time He may exalt you," 1 Peter 5:6

Diligence in Effort "...but I press on to make it my own, ..."

Proverbs 21:5 "The plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance, ..."

- 2 Peter 1:10-11 "Be all the more diligent to make your calling and election sure, for if you practice these qualities you will never fall. For in this way there will be richly provided for you an entrance into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."
 - "While God's choice of the elect is firm and certain in God (2 Tim. 2:19), it may not always be obvious to the individual Christian. Assurance of God's call comes through the evidence of the Holy Spirit's work in our lives (1 John 3:10, 14) ..."

Understanding of Relationship "... because Christ has made me His own."

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

I Corinthians 6:19-20 "Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were <u>bought</u> with a price. So glorify God in your body." John 15:16 "You did not choose me, but I chose you..."

Priorities in Choices "... But one thing I do..."

- 1 Corinthians 6:12 "'All things are lawful for me,' but not all things are helpful. 'All things are lawful for me,' but I will not be enslaved by anything."

Maintaining Attention to our Goal and Reward "I press on toward the goal for the prize"

☐ James 1:2-5 " that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing."
